

Thank you so very much for assisting in collecting the required 500 signatures to place my name on the March 2, 2010 Republican Primary Ballot in lieu of the \$1,000 filing fee. Please read the enclosed instructions prior to collecting signatures. Just a note, it's more expedient to keep the petition handy and ask people you know to sign, than it is to walk door to door. It is legal to solicit signatures at church, football games, or grocery stores, but not in any courthouse.

Instructions for Soliciting Signatures for Petition
500 Signatures required

Eligibility:

Person must be registered to vote, live in Pct 2 of Williams County (boundary lines described below) and willing to say they will be voting in the Republican Primary in March. If they do not have their voter registration number, ensure they print their birth date and I can look up their number.

Boundary lines for Pct 2:

Precinct 2 Williamson County begins at Hwy 183 at Spicewood Springs and follows Hwy 183 through Austin, Cedar Park, Leander, & Liberty Hill, to the county line north and east. The boundary stretches to the west from RR620 at Parmer and proceeds in a northwest direction with a boundary line at Sam Bass (CR175). It continues north moving also west with a boundary line at Cedar Hollow Road off Hwy 29 north to FM 3405.

Notarized Affidavit:

By signing the Affidavit at the bottom of page, you are stating you made sure individuals knew what they were signing by reading the top paragraph to them.

Deadlines:

Even though the Petition will be filed in December, it takes time to collect these petitions, count, and verify. Therefore, your cooperation in turning in these petitions as soon as possible is appreciated. You may send them in as you collect them by mailing to 420 Hernandos Loop Leander, Texas 78641, or dropping off on the porch in the drawer cabinet at 420 Hernandos Loop, leaving with one of the notaries suggested below, or call me and someone will pick them up from you. It is my hope to have all petitions back before Thanksgiving. Please keep one copy of the form as an original to copy in case you need additional forms!
